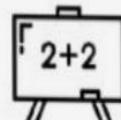
2. Draw place value chart of Indian system and International system neatly on a chart.

## **EVS Holiday Homework**

### **Session : 2024-25**

**Nature Journaling:** Encourage students to start a nature journal where they can record observations about plants, animals, and the environment around them. They can sketch what they see, describe the weather, and note any changes they observe over the summer.



**Plant a Sapling:** Motivate students to plant a sapling at home or in a community space. They can choose their favourite fruits, vegetables, or flowers to grow and document the growth process through photographs or drawings.
